Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR). The Organizing Authority is Troense Baadelaug in conjunction with the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA). The host fleet is Danish Fleet.
- 1.2 Decisions of the International Jury will be final in accordance with RRS 70.5.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P will apply
- 1.4 The prescriptions of the national authority, Danish Sailing Federation, shall not apply
- 1.5 RRS 32 will be changed to provide that courses will not be shortened.
- 1.6 RRS 33b will not apply.
- 1.7 RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 60 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- 1.8 RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.9 RRS 62.2 and RRS 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- 1.10 RRS A4.1 will be changed to provide that a boat failing to check in prior to the warning signal will be scored the same as a boat not starting in that race without a hearing.
- 1.11 In accordance with STCR 31.2.6. The race committee may broadcast race information on VHF channel 72 before and during each race. Failure of such information to be given or received, or the order in which OCSs calls are broadcasted, shall not be grounds for redress, except when a request for redress under this instruction is initiated by the race committee or the jury. This changes RRS 62.1.

2. Advertising

Boats will be required to display Event Advertising on the forward part of the hull and potentially at the boom. Out of respect to our title sponsor, advertising for tobacco products is strongly discouraged. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21, 26, 29 and 30 may compete. Entries are LOG plus 4.
- 3.2 Entries shall be submitted on the Official Online Entry Form not later than May 30th 2017 to the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association Central Office (organizing authority).
- 3.3 Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under the World Sailing Eligibility Code Regulation 19 shall be eligible to compete in this regatta.
- 3.4 For the purpose of RRS A Scoring: A competitor is not considered an entry until: (a) All fees are paid and (b) Measurement is completed.

4. Fees

The entry fee of 700USD includes boat and trailer parking, launching, hauling and invitations to social events for skipper and crew. Entry fees are due at time of entry and but not later than the entry due date (May 30th 2017). Late entry fees will not be accepted.

5. Schedule

- 5.1 Registration/check-in: from June 29. through July 1. 2017
- 5.2 Measurement: from June 29. through July 1. 2017 by appointment between 9:00 – 17:00
- 5.3 Schedule of Races: Racing will be July 2. through July 8. July 5. will be a Lay Day and July 9. is the Reserve Day.
There will be a practice race on July 1.



5.4 The schedule time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 11:30

6. Measurement

6.1 Measurement will take place at the Sports Hall at the school 1,5km west of Troense. Each participating boat shall have a valid Measurement Certificate in the name of the current owner, and Weight Certificate. Only boats that have completed registration, paid all entry fees, and passed the prescribed measurement check procedure by 17:00 July 1. are entitled to race. The International Jury may order that a boat be re-checked during the regatta.

6.2 Crews shall demonstrate compliance with crew weight limits in accordance with STCR 31.1.3 prior to end of measurement. Crews may be re-weighed during the event at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

6.3 Each boat shall show the sail number and national letters as indicated on the Official Entry Form and approved by the Measurer.

6.4 Bow numbers will be assigned and given to each participating boat. They shall be affixed to the hull according to the Sailing Instructions.

7. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at Troense Baadelaug race office by June 29. 2017.

8. Venue

Racing will be conducted Lunkebugten (Lunke bay) approximately 2-3 nautical miles south-east of Troense Baadelaug depending on wind direction

9. Courses

Courses will be according to STCR 34.

10. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each series score will be the total of her races scores with her worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed.

11. Berthing

Boats shall be at Troense Baadelaug harbor or their assigned berthing site commencing at 18:00 hours on July 1 until the conclusion of racing.

12. Haul-out Restrictions

The Organizing Authority may impose haul-out restrictions.

13. Diving Equipment and Plastic Pools

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

14. Radio Communication

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

15. Team and Private Support Boats

A boat shall receive no outside assistance from support boats or otherwise once she has left the dock for the day until the finish of the last race of the day, except in the case of emergency and/or towing supplied by the organizer and available to all participants.

16. Prizes

16.1 Perpetual Trophies will be awarded according to STCR 24.

16.2 Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through fifth.

16.3 Master's trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through third in the Series for skippers



aged 50 through 59 before the start of the first race. Competitors in the Master's Division will also compete for Series prizes (see 14.2).

16.4 Grand Master's trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through third in the Series for skippers aged 60 or over before the start of the first race. Competitors in the Grand Master's Division will also compete for Series prizes (see 14.2).

16.5 Daily prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through third in each race.

17. **Disclaimer**

The Organizing Authority shall require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the property of Troense Baadelaug or the Danish Sailing Federation. The Organizing Authority, their members, employees, officers and/or agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.

18. **Insurance**

18.1 Boats sailing in this regatta (each 'person in charge' see RRS 46) must be adequately insured and shall hold a valid insurance certificate showing proof of third party liability for racing risks, with a minimum cover of 1 million Euro per event or the equivalent.

18.2 The Organizing Authority is not responsible for verifying the status or validity of certificates.

19. **Rights to Use Name and Likeness**

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

20. **Changes To The Notice of Race**

The Organizing Authority may change the Notice of Race see RRS 89.2(b). Any such changes will be posted on the event website www.starworlds2017.com
